To whom it may concern,

The Romanian Academy, Cluj-Napoca Branch is announcing the organization of a selection procedure with the aim of signing a partnership agreement with a public, private, commercial or non-commercial partner institution (library, museum, archive, education and/or research complex, NGO) interested in submitting a funding application within the framework of RO-CULTURE Programme, financed through the EEA Grants 2014-2021. The theme of the call for proposals is: *Innovative cultural exhibitions of restored objects supported.*

A team of researchers and academics from the "Babeş-Bolyai" University of Cluj-Napoca (Transylvania), Romania, together with librarians from the Library of the Romanian Academy in Cluj-Napoca intend to apply for a EEA Grant with the purpose of restoring, digitizing and, thereafter, exposing (*in situ*, at the headquarters of the Library of the Romanian Academy in Cluj-Napoca as well as in a travelling multimedia exhibition) 21 Western codex fragments which are owned by the Library of the Romanian Academy in Cluj-Napoca.

Any institution from Donor States (Iceland-Liechtenstein-Norway), willing to:

- accept the role of consultant in multimedia exhibiting techniques and settings,
- activate as supervisors in the process of organizing a multimedia travelling exhibition based on 21 to be restored Western medieval manuscript fragments included in the bindings of early modern printed books from the Library of the Romanian Academy in Cluj-Napoca;
- ensure effective cooperation in the dissemination of the outcome of the project;
- co-organize and ensure the hosting of the multimedia travelling exhibition,

is more than welcome to apply.
